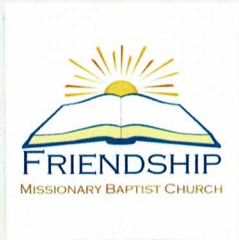

---

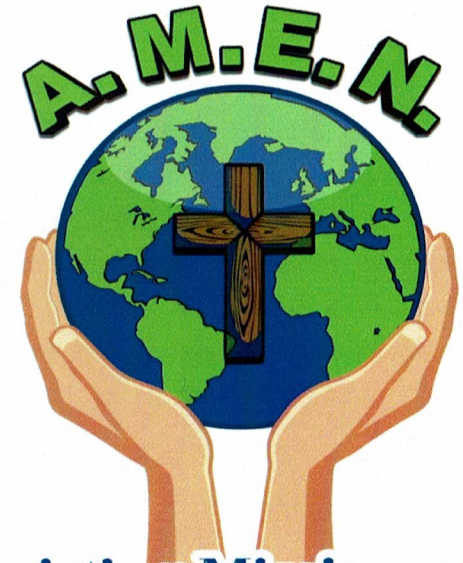
